## **Necessity of recording**

Sec. 1. Not more than forty-five (45) days after its execution, a lease of real estate for a period longer than three (3) years shall be recorded in the Miscellaneous Record in the recorder's office of the county in which the real estate is located. *As added by P.L.2-2002, SEC.16.*

# IC 32-31-2-2

## Failure to record lease; effect

Sec. 2. If a lease for a period longer than three (3) years is not recorded within forty-five (45) days after its execution, the lease is void against any subsequent purchaser, lessee, or mortgagee who acquires the real estate in good faith and for valuable consideration. *As added by P.L.2-2002, SEC.16.*
