Admissibility of privileged communications

- Sec. 1. The privileged communication between:
 - (1) a husband and wife;
 - (2) a health care provider and the health care provider's patient;
 - (3) a:
 - (A) licensed social worker;
 - (B) licensed clinical social worker;
 - (C) licensed marriage and family therapist;
 - (D) licensed mental health counselor;
 - (E) licensed addiction counselor; or
 - (F) licensed clinical addiction counselor;

and a client of any of the professionals described in clauses (A) through (F);

- (4) a school counselor and a student; or
- (5) a school psychologist and a student;

is not a ground for excluding evidence in any judicial proceeding resulting from a report of a child who may be a victim of child abuse or neglect or relating to the subject matter of the report or failing to report as required by IC 31-33.
