242.1295 Licensing restrictions.

In no event shall a license be issued for any restaurant or any dining facility in a hotel, motel, or inn, unless the applicant can demonstrate to the director or administrator that gross receipts of the restaurant or the dining facility from the sale of food for consumption on the premises is reasonably estimated to be not less than fifty percent (50%) of the total food and beverage receipts of such restaurant or dining facility for the license period.
