

### **610.020 Complaints.**

Except as otherwise provided in KRS Chapters 600 to 645:

- (1) The complaint and all subsequent court documents shall be entitled: "In the interest of ....., a child." The complaint shall be verified and may be upon information and belief. It shall set forth plainly:
  - (a) The facts which bring the child within the purview of KRS Chapters 600 to 645;
  - (b) The name, age and residence of the child;
  - (c) The name and residence of each parent;
  - (d) If the child has a legal guardian or is in the custody of or under the supervision of an adult other than a parent, the name and residence of such person;
  - (e) If no parent, guardian or other such person is known or can be found, the name and residence of the nearest known adult relative of the child; and
  - (f) If the child is in the custody or control of a person other than the parent, guardian or nearest adult relative, the name and residence of such person.
- (2) If any of the facts required to be stated in the complaint are not known by the complainant, it shall so state.
