242.1238 Limited sale precinct election for sale of alcoholic beverages at horse racetrack in county containing a city of the third or fourth class.

- Other provisions of the Kentucky Revised Statutes notwithstanding, in a county containing a city of the third or fourth class, a limited sale precinct election may be held in any precinct containing a horse racetrack. The election shall be conducted in the same manner as provided for in KRS 242.1292. Upon approval of the proposition, a Nonquota type 1 retail drink license may be issued in accordance with KRS 243.265. Nothing in this section shall be construed as authorizing the issuance of any alcoholic beverage licenses other than for the premises of a horse racetrack pursuant to KRS 243.260.
- (2) A petition seeking a local option election under this section shall state "We the undersigned registered voters hereby petition for an election on the following question: 'Are you in favor of the sale of alcoholic beverages in (official name of the horse racetrack located in the designated precinct)?"".
