## 311A.115 Educational course on AIDS for paramedics.

The Kentucky Board of Emergency Medical Services shall, by regulation, require an applicant for licensure as a paramedic to have completed a board or Cabinet for Health and Family Services-approved educational course on the transmission, control, treatment and prevention of the human immunodeficiency virus and acquired immunodeficiency syndrome with an emphasis on appropriate behavior and attitude change.
