216C.150 Removal and replacement of panel member. (Declared void – See LRC Note Below)

The chairperson may remove a member of the panel if the chairperson determines that the member is not fulfilling the duties imposed upon the panel members by this chapter. If a member is removed under this section, a new member shall be selected in the manner provided in KRS 216C.100 for dismissed panel members.

On November 15, 2018, the Kentucky Supreme Court ruled that the 2017 Medical Review Panel Act, of which this section is part, violated Kentucky Constitution Section 14's guarantee of a right of access to the courts to obtain a remedy for injury and is, therefore, void in its entirety.
