SUBCHAPTER II—MISCELLANEOUS PROVISIONS

Introduction into, or sale in, State or Territory or District of Columbia of dairy or food products falsely labeled or branded.

Act June 25, 1938, ch. 675, \$1002(a), formerly \$902(a), 52 Stat. 1059; renumbered \$1002(a), Pub. L. 111–31, div. A, title I, \$101(b)(2), June 22, 2009, 123 Stat. 1784, which repealed sections 1 to 5, 7 to 14, and 15 of this title, provided that the repeal of those sections should take effect upon the effective date of act June 25, 1938, which was to take effect twelve months after the date of its enactment. Act June 23, 1939, ch. 242, \$2(b), 53 Stat. 854, provided that: "The provisions of such act of June 30, 1906, as amended, to the extent that they impose, or au
