§ 1221. Short title; applicability; definitions

(a) Short title

This chapter may be cited as the "General Education Provisions Act".

(b) Applicability of chapter

- (1) Except as otherwise provided, this chapter applies to each applicable program of the Department of Education.
- (2) Except as otherwise provided, this chapter does not apply to any contract made by the Department of Education.

(c) Definitions

As used in this chapter, the following terms have the following meanings:

- (1) The term "applicable program" means any program for which the Secretary or the Department has administrative responsibility as provided by law or by delegation of authority pursuant to law. The term includes each program for which the Secretary or the Department has administrative responsibility under the Department of Education Organization Act [20 U.S.C. 3401 et seq.] or under Federal law effective after the effective date of
 - (2) The term "applicable statute" means—
 - (A) the Act or the title, part, section, or any other subdivision of an Act, as the case may be, that authorizes the appropriation for an applicable program;
 - (B) this chapter; and
 - (C) any other statute that by its terms expressly controls the administration of an applicable program.
